## NOTICE UNDER THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012, TO CONFIRM THE "MAKING" OF CHELVESTON CUM CALDECOTT NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 2016-2031

In accordance with **Regulation 18(2)** of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 ("the Regulations"), as amended; on **17 July 2017** East Northamptonshire Council resolved to "make" (adopt) the Chelveston cum Caldecott Neighbourhood Plan 2016-2031. From hereon, under section 38A of the 2004 Act the Neighbourhood Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for East Northamptonshire, for the Parish of Chelveston cum Caldecott.

The Council resolved, on 17 July 2017, to:

- Adopt the Chelveston cum Caldecott Neighbourhood Plan 2016-2031;
  and
- Replace Policy AG4 from the 1996 District Local Plan by Chelveston cum Caldecott Neighbourhood Plan Policy H2.
