## **NOTICE UNDER THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012, TO CONFIRM THE “MAKING” OF THE RAUNDS NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN 2011-2031**

In accordance with **Regulation 18(2)** of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”), as amended; on **27 November 2017** East Northamptonshire Council resolved to “make” (adopt) the Raunds Neighbourhood Plan 2011-2031. From hereon, under section 38A of the 2004 Act the Neighbourhood Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for East Northamptonshire, for the Parish of Raunds.

The Council resolved, on 27 November 2017, to:

- Adopt the Raunds Neighbourhood Plan 2011-2031; and
- Replace policies S5, RL3, RL4 and RA2 from the 1996 District Local Plan, by Raunds Neighbourhood Plan policies R5, R9, R10, R12 and R20.
