NOTICE UNDER THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012, TO CONFIRM THE “MAKING” OF THE RUSHDEN NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

In accordance with **Regulation 18(2)** of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”), as amended; on **4 June 2018** East Northamptonshire Council resolved to “make” (adopt) the Rushden Neighbourhood Plan 2011-2031. From hereon, under section 38A of the 2004 Act the Neighbourhood Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for East Northamptonshire, for the Parish of Rushden.

The Council resolved, on 4 June 2018, to:

- Adopt the Rushden Neighbourhood Plan; and
- Replace policies S5, RL3, RL4, RU2 and RU4 from the 1996 District Local Plan, by Rushden Neighbourhood Plan policies H1, R2, CL1, CL2, CL3, CL4 and CL5.
