Brigstock Neighbourhood Development Plan

Information Statement

A referendum relating to the adoption of the Brigstock Neighbourhood Development Plan 2011-2031 will be held on **Thursday 6th December 2018**.

The question which will be asked in the referendum is:

“Do you want East Northamptonshire District Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Brigstock to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

The referendum area is identified on the map below, which is included with this Information Statement. The Referendum area is identical to the area which was designated by East Northamptonshire Council as the Brigstock Neighbourhood Area on 11th May 2015.

A person is entitled to vote in the referendum if on 6th December 2018:

- he or she is entitled to vote in a local government election in the Referendum area; and
- his or her qualifying address for the election is in the referendum area. A person's qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be registered.

The referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the referendum is £2,362, plus £0.059 for each entry in the register of electors. The number of persons entitled to vote in the referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is 1,110.

The referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.

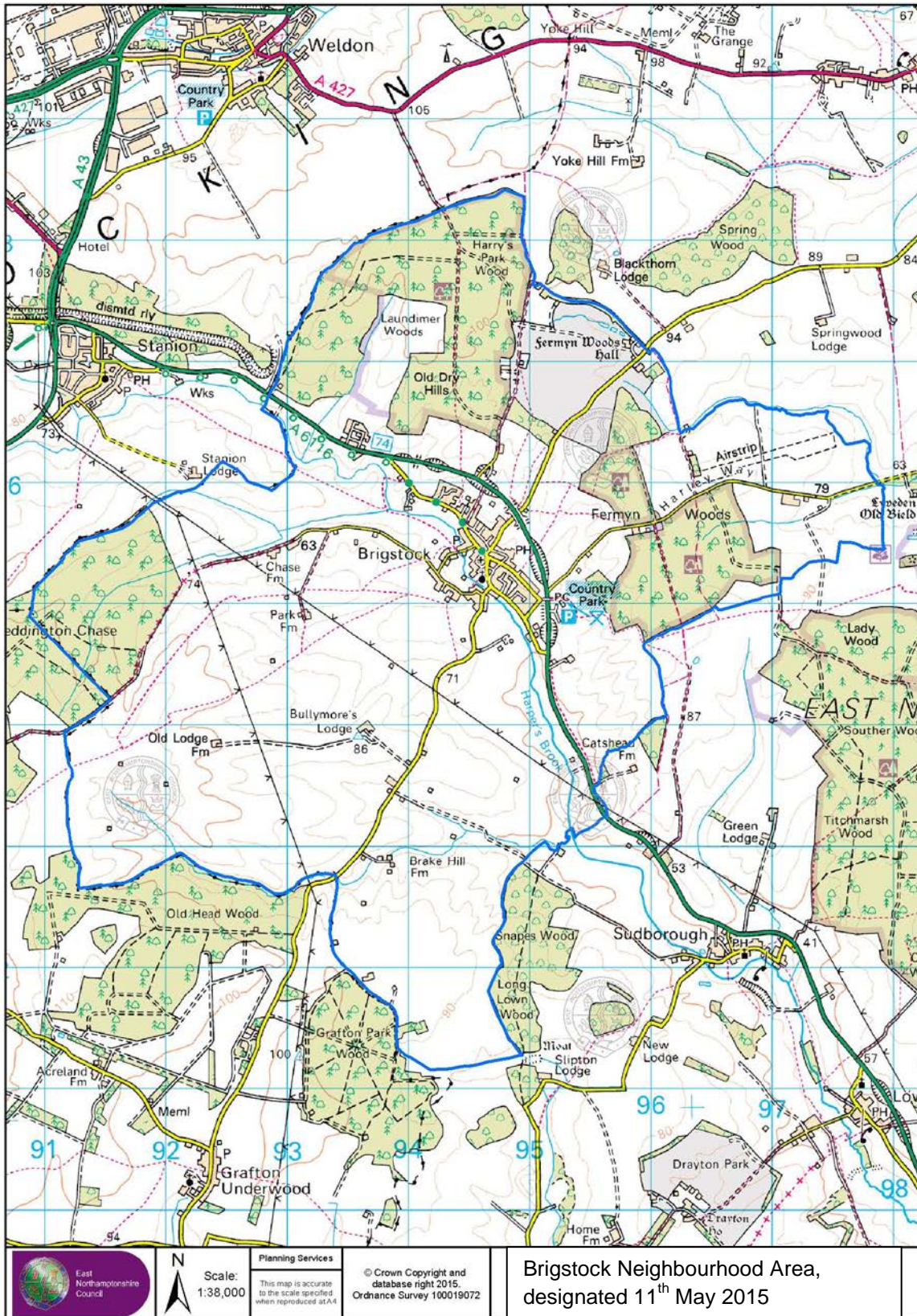
