## **NOTICE UNDER THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012, TO CONFIRM THE “MAKING” OF THE BRIGSTOCK NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2011-2031**

In accordance with **Regulation 18(2)** of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”), as amended; on **21 January 2019** East Northamptonshire Council resolved to “make” (adopt) the Brigstock Neighbourhood Development Plan 2011-2031. From hereon, under section 38A of the 2004 Act the Neighbourhood Development Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for East Northamptonshire, for the Parish of Brigstock.

The Council resolved, on 21 January 2019, to:

- Adopt the Brigstock Neighbourhood Development Plan 2011-2031; and
- Replace policies 2, 4, 5, 9, 10, 15, 23 and BC1 from the 2011 Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan by Brigstock Neighbourhood Development Plan policies B1(B), B2, B6(C), B9, B10, B11, B13, B15, B18 and B19.
