## **NOTICE UNDER THE NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING (GENERAL) REGULATIONS 2012, TO CONFIRM THE “MAKING” OF THE WARMINGTON NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN 2019-2031**

In accordance with **Regulation 18(2)** of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (“the Regulations”), as amended; on **17<sup>th</sup> December 2019** East Northamptonshire Council resolved to “make” (adopt) the Warmington Neighbourhood Development Plan 2019-2031. From hereon, under section 38A of the 2004 Act the Neighbourhood Development Plan forms part of the statutory development plan for East Northamptonshire, for the Parish of Warmington.

The Council resolved, on 17<sup>th</sup> December 2019, to:

- Adopt the Warmington Neighbourhood Development Plan 2019 - 2031; and
- Replace Policies 15 and WAR1 of the Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan by Neighbourhood Plan Policies W2 and W12.
