Notice of proposed changes to the Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan (submitted 11 January 2008)

This notice has been prepared in accordance with Regulation 32 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Development) (England) Regulations 2004. Following submission of the Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan and accompanying documents to the Secretary of State on 11 January 2008, a number of representations were received proposing minor and/ or editorial changes to the Plan document. In a small number of cases, the Council has resolved to support such changes.

Working within the requirements of Regulation 32(2), the Council has prepared a list of proposed changes to the Plan (known as the "Schedule of proposed changes to the Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan (submitted January 2008)").

The statutory 6 week consultation period for the Schedule of proposed changes will start on 20 June 2008 and finish on 1 August 2008.

Representations on this document are invited, and must be received by 5.30pm on Friday, 1 August. These will be posted on the Council's website, along with other related documents.

- (i) Publication of recommendations by the person appointed to carry out an independent examination ("the Inspector");
- (ii) Adoption of the Rural North, Oundle and Thrapston Plan.
