This Message originated outside your organisation.

I understand that the Masterplan Framework Document (MFD) for the Rushden East SUE will now be part of the new district wide Local Plan Part 2. Could I please resubmit my comments made during the last consultation, Feb/March 2020, for consideration.

I appreciate that the document is not to resolve or enter into detailed matters for the SUE and the required references to crime and disorder should be covered within the appropriate sections of a design code but certain elements do raise certain issues to me that would not be too out of place. As you will be aware the main reference supporting crime prevention in local policy is JCS policy 8 and security measures having regard to the principles of Secured by Design which I understand supercedes the SPD Designing Out Crime.

- Page 37 – Parking 2.3.36: **Add** - *'to ensure that it does not dominate the street scene'*.
Tandem parking will be avoided as resultant on street parking causes safety issues or neighbour disputes, inconvenient parking facilities can lead to irresponsible parking and make access routes for emergency vehicles impossible. This may cause significant delays when responding to incidents which may lead to loss of life. - Remove last sentence, leave ref quoted as above just to small clusters/courtyards!
- Page 38 Planning Application Requirements: Take out last sentence and insert – **Parking should be within the guidance of Secured by Design principles.**
- Page 61 c. Well-designed places – Add - **Have public spaces that feel safe, secure and attractive for all to use. Good design means a wide range of crimes and anti-social behaviour less likely to happen by making committing those incidents more difficult** g. Healthy places – Ammend to **Healthy and Safe Communities** – Add **Which are safe and accessible, so that crime and disorder, and the fear of crime, do not undermine the quality of life or community cohesion.**

I hope the above are clear and you can consider there inclusion. If you would like to discuss the above I would be pleased to do so. I also look forward to being part of any design group consultation for any subsequent design code.
