

ADDITIONAL NOTICE OF REFERENDUM

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING REFERENDUM FOR THE HARGRAVE NEIGHBOURHOOD AREA

1. A referendum will be held to decide on the question below:

“Do you want North Northamptonshire Council to use the neighbourhood plan for Hargrave to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?”

2. The poll will take place on Thursday, 30th June 2022 between the hours of 7am and 10pm.
3. This is an additional notice to make readers aware of a procedural error as the correct version of the Hargrave Neighbourhood Plan was not published 28 days in advance of the Referendum. However, the error has been corrected which is allowed under Section 46 of the Electoral Administrative Act 2006. **The electorate are therefore advised that if they viewed the Plan prior to 1st June 2022, then they should review the correct version which was published on 1st June 2022.**
4. Applications to register to vote must have reached the Electoral Registration Officer at the Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering NN15 7QX by 12 midnight on Tuesday 14th June 2022. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
5. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes and amendments or cancellations of proxy votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering NN15 7QX by 5pm on Wednesday, 15th June 2022.
6. New applications to vote by proxy at this referendum must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering NN15 7QX by 5pm on Wednesday 22nd June 2022.
7. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this referendum on grounds of physical incapacity or for work/service reasons must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Municipal Offices, Bowling Green Road, Kettering NN15 7QX by 5pm on Thursday, 30th June 2022. The physical
