

## In My Area User Guide

This is the window you see when you first open the map:



### To move around the map

You can move around on the map by either dragging the map with your cursor or using the arrow buttons




## To zoom in and out

- To zoom in and out you can use the wheel on the mouse. (rolling forward zooms in, rolling backward zooms out) or
- You can use the scale slide where you can drag the small grey bar up to zoom in and down to zoom out or




- Click on the + (zoom in) and – (zoom out) buttons accordingly.
- You can also hold the Shift key and draw a square using the mouse over the area you wish to zoom in.



## To search for an Address

You can use this search box to type in a postcode or an address. If you only know part of an address you can use \* as a wild card (e.g. 10 Church\*):

It will then ask you to specify the property. To do this simply click on the appropriate address:






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## To Select a Location

You can also select a location using the pin and the map. You can drag the purple pin from the side of the map to anywhere on the map to select a location.



You can use these buttons to change between the different information:



This is the home button and will return you to the home menu.



This is the information button and will take you to information about your local area. You can either click on this button, do an address search or put the pin in a location.



This lists any related webpages or surveys you may be interested in.



This will allow you to turn on or off information available to display on the map.



This refreshes the map to the home menu and original map display

This is the home menu and lists the information available from In My Area:


## Map Layers




This allows you to add different information to view on the map:

If you put a tick in the box against the information it will automatically appear on the map. You can turn on as many layers as you like. To turn them off simply un-tick the box and the information will automatically disappear.



When you have information displayed on the map you can then find out more information about that particular topic by clicking on the map. A balloon pops up with information related to that feature. Information such as the name of a school, grade of a listed building, or website of a hotel can be found this way.




To remove all the visible layers; at the bottom of the list of information there is a link that says 'Hide all'. If you click this then all the information you have added will be removed.



## Refresh Button



If you want to return to where you were before you started. This button will remove any pins, searches or information you may have added and take you back to the window you saw when you first opened the map:
