### Oundle By-Election Result

#### Purpose of report

This report is submitted to advise the Council of the result of the by-election held for the vacancy in the Oundle ward on 15 November 2012.

#### 1.0 Background

1.1 A by-election was held for the vacant seat for the Oundle ward of East Northamptonshire on 15 November 2012.

1.2 The result of the by-election was declared as follows:

KING, Paul Andrew	The Labour Party Candidate	681 votes	
SMID, George Jiri	Liberal Democrat	230 votes	
VOWLES, Jake	The Conservative Party Candidate	1003 votes	ELECTED

The electorate for the Oundle ward was 4416 and turnout was 44.27%

2.1 That the election of Jake Vowles as a Councillor for the Oundle ward be noted.
