Sale of Plant Equipment

Purpose of report:

To consider the sale of plant equipment.

1.0 Introduction

- 1.1 The Council's Small Assets Disposal Policy requires the Policy and Resources Committee to approve the sale of items that are expected to achieve more than £5,000 in value.
- 1.2 Because the Council is currently in the process of selling land at Newton Road, Rushden, it needs to dispose of old plant equipment which is currently stored there.
- 1.3 It is anticipated that the value of the plant equipment will be between £5,000 and £10,000 and Councillors are therefore asked to approve disposal of the plant equipment which is likely to be done by auction.
- 1.4 All policy requirements will be followed prior to any sale taking place.
