1.0 Background

- 1.1 The Committee was presented with the suite of reports on 21st November 2016 and 20th February with a view to publishing these as finalised documents. At the most recent Committee on the 20th February, there were still queries on certain parts of the data presented in the reports. Consequently, the reports were not agreed as an evidence base, pending further responses to comments.
- 1.2 This report summarises the latest comments that were raised (Appendix 1) and provides a response from the consultants (KKP) explaining whether and/or how they have been incorporated into the documents. - 1.3 The Planning Policy Committee received two draft assessments for the first part of the work undertaken (PPC 22nd February 2016). The Open Space assessment has been modified to include the whole district, to reflect the change in direction to progress a Local Plan Part 2 as a District Wide document. In addition, the playing pitch assessment report has been updated and completed following consideration of the draft report at the February 2016 meeting of PPC. The Open Space Standards Paper and the Playing Pitch Strategy and Action Plan were produced to complete the evidence base required.

2.0 Updates and Comments

2.1 Comments received have been considered by the consultants (KKP) and, where applicable, have been incorporated into the studies. A full list of comments and responses from KKP are found in Appendix 1. The updated reports are viewable on the website through the web link in in Paragraph 1.2.

3.0 Summary

3.1 The overall findings and recommendations of the studies have not significantly changed since the updates. The updated studies form part of the evidence base for the Local

Plan Part 2. The findings and recommendations in the reports identify where there are shortfalls in provision, or quality issues within the District. The studies will influence policy development for the Local Plan Part 2 as well as providing on-going evidence to help determine planning applications. A summary of what the studies show was reported at 21 November 2016 Planning Policy Committee (Agenda Item 5).
