#### 1.0 Introduction

1.1 In March 2007 a report was placed in front of this Committee detailing various issues raised as a result of the Licensing Act 2003. As part of this discussion members asked that they receive information relating to crime associated with licensed premises every six months.

#### 2.0 Crime Statistics

2.1 The attached report in Appendix One is provided to East Northamptonshire Council every month and details the crime which is reported against each licensed premises. It does not include crime outside or near to these premises. The report details the name of the premises, type of offence and the number of crimes.

In addition to the information provided by premises the Police have given us some general information relating to violent offences. These are recorded on a monthly basis and form Appendix Two of this report.

#### 3.0 Conclusion

3.1 This information is provided to members for information and to assist them in identifying the impact of the licensed trade on crime and disorder.
